The Religious Education Program of St. Mary's Parish meets on Wednesday nights in two sessions. The elementary grades, 1-6, meet from 6 - 7 pm and the middle and high school levels, grades 7-10, meet from 7:10 until 8:10 pm. Classes are held in St. Mary's Religious Education Center.

Fees are nominal and may be adjusted to reflect costs to the program.

Sessions follow the public school calendar, and approximately 30 weeks of classes are offered per year. Preparation for the sacraments requires some additional responsibilities outside of class periods.

Supervised study periods are offered on Wednesday nights for older students who are dropped off with younger siblings, and for younger students who are waiting for older siblings. Students need to bring their own schoolwork or books to read. A computer is available in the office for students to use.

The Religious Education Program is provided for St. Mary parishioners only. Families must be registered members involved in the parish. The participation or assistance of parents is requested, as needed.
